


The new Golf R32 is powered by an exceptional 3.2 litre V6 petrol engine, capable of generating a phenomenal 250 PS, and producing a hefty 320 Nm of torque at just 2,800 rpm. Coupled with a slick six speed manual gearbox, the V6 engine can accelerate the R32 from 0-62 mph in an impressive 6.5 seconds. Alternatively, it can be coupled with the superb automatic DSG gearbox, which allows super-swift gear changes without interrupting the acceleration of the car under power, resulting in a 0-62 mph time of just 6.2 seconds.

The new Golf R32 is fitted with the sophisticated 4MOTION four wheel drive system, whereby power is redistributed to the wheels that need it most, ensuring all four wheels work in harmony. The result is greater traction, improved safety and added driving pleasure, on any type of road.

Inside you'll notice a comprehensively equipped interior. Deep front sport seats, 2Zone electronic climate control, an eight speaker radio/CD player, rain sensor and automatic dimming interior rear-view mirror, automatic coming/leaving home lighting function and dusk sensor combine to produce a luxurious interior specification with great attention to detail.

The gleaming chrome-plated radiator grille surround reinforces the story. Add to that the confident shape of the C pillar and the curved breakaway edge of the rear, giving real body definition, and the story of aerodynamic design and sports performance is complete.

It's not just aesthetic appeal where the Passat excels. Every journey is a special experience, thanks to Volkswagen's superb range of economical, high-torque petrol and diesel engines, all designed to make driving pure pleasure. The four FSI petrol variants benefit from innovative direct injection technology. The powerful four cylinder 1.6 litre engine with six speed gearbox develops a healthy 115 PS. The exceptional 2.0 litre engine offers even greater drive dynamics, generating 150 PS and ensuring others only have the Passat's elegant rear end to admire. The most recent additions to the Passat engine line-up are the much acclaimed 2.0 litre FSI 200 PS engine and the powerful 3.2 litre FSI V6 4MOTION 250 PS engine, both available for Sport and SEL models.

The three diesel variants are particularly sophisticated. First is the four cylinder 1.9 litre TDI engine with a five speed gearbox, developing 105 PS and 250 Nm of torque at 1,900 rpm. The second diesel option, the powerful 2.0 litre TDI 140 PS engine with a six speed manual or six speed automatic DSG gearbox produces added performance. Thirdly is the much anticipated 2.0 litre TDI 170 PS engine, soon to be available for the Passat Sport and SEL, please contact your Volkswagen retailer for further details.



This is closely followed by the 2.0 litre FSI 150 PS and 2.0 litre FSI 200 PS. A more powerful 3.2 litre FSI V6 4MOTION is also available which develops 250 PS.

If you're looking for exceptional economy, the new Passat Estate offers a range of three diesel engines. Choose from either the 1.9 litre TDI 105 PS or 2.0 litre TDI 140 PS. All Tourans feature multiple storage compartments in the passenger and luggage areas, cruise control, multifunction computer, a single CD player, semi-automatic air conditioning and an extensive range of safety equipment.

There are three petrol and three diesel engines to choose from. In addition to a 1.6 litre 102 PS petrol unit, there are two further units, the 1.6 litre 115 PS and the 2.0 litre 150 PS. These two engines utilise FSI technology, which gives greater economy, improved cleanliness and better performance. The diesel engines include a 1.9 litre TDI 90 PS, a 1.9 litre TDI 105 PS and the 2.0 litre TDI 140 PS, which is one of the most powerful diesels in its class. All engines meet EURO 4 approval, meaning you can benefit from reduced company car tax.

Depending on the engine you choose there are a number of gearbox options available. There's a five and six speed manual, a six speed automatic tiptronic or the new six speed automatic DSG which offers a genuine alternative to a manual gearbox.





Sharan. Engineering for all the family.

If your needs suggest an MPV, but you don't wish to compromise on quality and engineering, look no further than the Volkswagen Sharan. There are four engines available – two petrol and two diesel. As a choice of petrol engines, there's a 2.0 litre 115 PS unit available for the S and SE or a more powerful turbocharged 1.8 litre 150 PS version for the Sport.

Two diesels are available, a 1.9 litre TDI 115 PS or a 2.0 litre TDI 140 PS, both featuring Volkswagen's 'Pumpe Düse' technology giving excellent pulling power together with reduced exhaust emissions.

Every Sharan is equipped with five rear seats, each one contoured to offer luxurious support. But the other great beauty of the Sharan is its immense practicality – by removing the rear seats you can open up a massive 2,610 cubic litres of storage space.

Touareg. Broaden your horizons with four wheel drive.

What is it that you demand from a luxury 4x4? Superb off-road ability or supreme on-road comfort and agility? But why should you have to make this decision – especially when the Touareg can sense its surroundings and decide for you?

For example, if you're cruising on the motorway the optional Continuous Damping Control (CDC) air suspension (standard with V10 TDI engine) can lower the vehicle ensuring a safe, agile ride. On the other hand, if you're off-road the Touareg can give itself up to 300 mm of ground clearance, whilst in really tricky situations it can transfer 100% of the engine's power to just one wheel.

The new Touareg Altitude trim level is also available and enhances the Touareg's distinctive exterior. Available on all engines the Altitude's features include a unique body styling kit, tinted windows, sports polished twin exhaust tailpipes and dynamic alloy wheels offering a stylish new look as well as superb on- and off-road performance.

There is one decision you'll have to make for yourself: which engine to choose. There's the 3.6 litre V6 petrol developing 280 PS and transporting you to 62 mph in just 8.7 seconds, or the 4.2 litre 310 PS V8 capable of 0-62 mph in a mere 8.1 seconds. Alternatively, there's a 2.5 litre TDI diesel unit, developing 174 PS. If you think you might need a little more power, consider the 3.0 litre V6 TDI which provides 225 PS or the 5.0 litre V10 TDI capable of producing 313 PS and a sprightly dash to 62 mph in only 7.8 seconds.


Offering inspired comfort, style and power, the Phaeton is a car that will deliver immense driving pleasure every time you take to the road.

The creators of the Phaeton strived for perfection – the result is a car that will stir the senses from the moment you enter the cabin. Once inside, you will instantly appreciate the attention to detail, the technology and the supreme comfort that can only be found in a car of this class.

You can choose from three petrol engines: the 3.2 litre V6 240 PS, the 4.2 litre V8 335 PS or the revolutionary 6.0 litre W12 providing 450 PS, taking the Phaeton from standstill to 62 mph in only 6.1 seconds. The 3.0 litre V6 TDI and 5.0 litre V10 TDI diesel alternatives are also impressive. In fact the 5.0 litre TDI version provides 313 PS and a maximum torque of 750 Nm at a mere 2,000 rpm. The 3.0 litre V6 TDI also impresses with a 225 PS and a top speed of 145 mph, where the law permits. Coupled to each of the engines is 4MOTION technology, meaning enhanced traction and improved handling.

As you may expect, the list of options is as comprehensive as the level of equipment already fitted as standard. For example, you may choose to take advantage of additional rear legroom by specifying a long wheelbase model, or the enhanced comfort of the 4 seat pack.

When you aim for perfection, there's no room for compromise.

The Volkswagen Warranty.

Three-year Warranty.

All Volkswagen passenger cars now come with a three-year/60,000 miles warranty, which protects your car against the failure of most mechanical and electrical components due to manufacturing defects. This comprises a two-year manufacturer's warranty with unlimited mileage plus a further one-year/60,000 miles (whichever is soonest) Retailer Warranty. Should the mileage exceed 60,000 miles within the first two years, the manufacturer's two-year warranty will still be valid. If an additional warranty for subsequent years or higher mileage is desired, it may be purchased from any authorised Volkswagen retailer or repairer; however, this additional warranty must be purchased before the mileage reaches 60,000. Full details of the three-year warranty are available from your authorised Volkswagen retailer or repairer.

Three-year Paint Warranty.

The paintwork of the Volkswagen range is covered against manufacturing defects for a period of three years. Naturally, the vehicle must be cared for in compliance with the operating instructions which will be found in your vehicle handbook. Please consult your authorised Volkswagen retailer or repairer for full warranty details.

Body Protection Warranty.

The internal body sections and panels of the Volkswagen range are covered against rusting through from the inside for 12 years, with the exception of the Sharan which is covered for six years. Naturally, the vehicle must be cared for in compliance with the operating instructions. Please consult your authorised Volkswagen retailer or repairer for full warranty details.

Service Intervals

Volkswagen are pleased to offer you a choice on how your Volkswagen is serviced. The appropriate selection is entirely dependent on how the car is likely to be driven and its general use. To help you identify which type of service would be most suitable, please refer to the following guide.

The Time and Distance Service is recommended for vehicles that will cover less than 10,000 miles in 12 months and if the vehicle is likely to be used in the following way:

- Predominantly urban driving, short journeys with frequent cold starts.
- Activities regularly producing high engine loading, e.g. frequent hill climbs, driving with vehicle fully loaded and towing.
- Uneconomical driving style using high rpms with heavy acceleration and heavy braking.

The LongLife Service is recommended for vehicles with a daily mileage of more than 25 miles and if the vehicle is likely to be used in the following way:

- Driven regularly mainly on longer distance journeys.
- Predominantly driven at a constant speed with minimum vehicle and engine loading and minimal towing.
- Economical driving style using lower rpms.

The choice of service will determine the specific service intervals for your vehicle and does differ for certain vehicles within the range. Please consult your authorised Volkswagen retailer or repairer for full details and advice.

A comprehensive range of accessories from alloy wheels to carpet mats is available to complement the factory-fitted option list.
